

TOWN OF WILLARD BOARD MEETING

December 14, 2020

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 6:00 P.M. with the pledge of allegiance. Those in attendance were Chairman Nelson, Supervisors Bentley and Taft, Treasurer Engelking, Deputy Treasurer Barrois, Clerk Nelson, Deputy Clerk Simpson, and Scott Rood.

**AGENDA:** There were no changes to the agenda.

**MINUTES:** Motion by Taft seconded by Bentley and carried to approve as printed.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** The Treasurer's report showed November receipts of \$148.56.; disbursements of \$13,776.17 resulting in an ending balance of \$63,552.72 which includes the equipment and contingency funds totaling \$15,099.29. Motion by Bentley, seconded by Taft and carried to approve as presented.

**APPROVAL OF BILLS TO BE PAID:** Motion by Taft, seconded by Bentley and carried to pay the bills as presented.

**CLERK'S REPORT/APPROVE PERMITS ISSUED:** The Clerk explained the purpose of the Town Advocacy Council that is the lobbying group of the WTA. This is the time of year that they ask municipalities to join at twenty-five cents per town resident (our population is 526). Motion by Taft, seconded by Bentley and carried that we join the group at a cost of \$131.50.

**BUILDING/OTHER PERMITS:** There were no requests.

**PUBLIC INPUT:** There was no public input.

**COUNTY SUPERVISOR REPORT:** Jim Meyer called earlier this afternoon and said he would be unable to attend this evening as he was in Wausau.

**OLD BUSINESS:** There was no old business.

**NEW BUSINESS: Approve Borrowing Resolution from BCPL:** Supervisor Bentley read the preamble and resolution from the Bureau of Commissioners of Public Lands. Motion by Bentley, seconded by Taft to approve as read. Roll call vote: Chairman Nelson-yea; Supervisor Taft-yea; Supervisor Bentley-yea. There were no nay votes and the motion carried.

**BOARD MEMBER REPORTS/CONCERNS:** The new Welcome to the Town of Willard road signs are up. We did receive approval from WIS DOT to put them up and the approval is on file.

Supervisor Bentley had a concern about the property on Broken Arrow Road that Parrish Bennett put a mobile home on as there are numerous cars and campers accumulating on the property. The board discussed this issue and asked the clerk to send a letter with a copy of the town ordinances regarding abandoned vehicles and requiring a junk yard permit. The letter should include a copy of the ordinance and asking him to respond to the board within thirty days as to what his intentions are. If he does not respond, we can fine him for violation of the ordinance (Chapter 7.08)

**AGENDA FOR JANUARY 11, 2021 MEETING:** Jim Mataczynski of the Lake Holcombe Veterans Memorial Group has asked to be on the agenda.

Motion by Taft, seconded by Bentley and carried to adjourn at 6:30 P.M.
