

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2018 – 2
TOWN OF WILLARD
RUSK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Willard, Rusk County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the Treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.

The term of office for the appoint position shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed three (3) years per Wi. Stat. Sec. 60.30(1e)(c). The town board may re-appoint the officer for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for “cause” as defined under Wi. Stat. Sec. 17.001 and required by Wi. Stat. Sec. 60.30(1e)(f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on November 6, 2018. The referendum question shall be: “Shall the person holding the office of the Treasurer in the Town of Willard be appointed by the town board?”

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per Wi. Stat. Sec. 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by Wi. Stat. Sec. 60.30(1e)(b).
