

Town of Willard Ordinances Public Hearing – Chapter 19 – December 9, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bob Nelson at t 6:07 PM. Board members present were Chairman Bob Nelson, Supervisor Mark Taft, Supervisor Chris Olson, Clerk MJ Nelson, Deputy Clerk Jenny Hengst, Treasurer Shannon Barrois and Deputy Treasurer Linda Bentley.

Public in attendance were Jackie and Brad Mc Daniel, Ray and Malea Willmarth, Jessa Raither and Scott Rood.

Jackie McDaniel with LHIA presented to the board adding 3 no wake buoys to bridge on County Road M and 3 to the bridge on State Hwy 27, Silver Bridge, by Phat Bob's at Big Swede's. LHIA will put up buoys to mark a no wake zone and remove them. Storage has arranged. This would be no cost to the township and was the original ordinance was adopted in 2014.

Once the board approves Jackie with LHIA will submit all the forms, which she has completed. Next step is submitting to the WI Game Warden to approve. Once the Game Warden approves it , it will come back to the board to adopt. That should take place in April 2025.

Opened to questions which were costs associated and there are none. It was asked if there will be buoys by the blue bridge on County Road D . Jackie explained that the Town of Washington did not come to the meeting with the other town chairs and they were not interested in being a part of the request. It was asked if "Slow Down" could be painted on the bridge to warn boaters about the safety issue. Chairman Nelson said he is in contact with the State Patrol and they are assisting with the rules allowed by the Department of Transportation. Mrs. McDaniel said the LHIA would not be a part of this as they are not addressing DOT issues.
